

**ORDER**

On August 10, 2021, due to increased infection & hospitalization rates associated with the Delta variant, COVID-19 procedures were reinstated. After an initial dramatic increase, the infection & hospitalization rates for COVID-19 have now dropped significantly. Accordingly, on October 21, 2021, Judge Jason E. Ashford of the State Court of Houston County issued an Order rescinding the mask mandate for that court.

The Perry Municipal Court COVID-19 Operating Guidelines are hereby **RESCINDED**. Those attending Perry Municipal Court are no longer required to abide by the COVID-19 guidelines and are expected to use common sense and common courtesy regarding their appearance at Court. Anyone wishing to wear a mask is welcome and encouraged to do so.
