

MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING OF THE PERRY CITY COUNCIL
JUNE 19, 2007

1. Call to Order: Mayor James Worrall, called to order the regular meeting of the Perry City Council held June 19, 2007 at 6:00 p.m.

3. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag: Rev. Dennis Harden gave the invocation and Council Member Riley Hunt led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

5. Consent Agenda Items:
 - 5a. Approved meeting minutes of June 5, 2007 work session and regular meeting. Council Member Hunt moved to approve the meeting minutes of Council's June 5, 2007 work session regular meeting. Council Member James Moore seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

6. Old Business:

6a. Ordinances for Second Readings:

Adopted Ordinance 2007-26 to rezone 96.454 acres located at 2000 and 2008 Hwy 127 from Houston County. City Manager Lee Gilmour gave the second reading of an ordinance to rezone 96.454 acres located at 2000 and 2008 Hwy 127 from Houston County R-AG, Residential Agricultural District to City of Perry R-2A, Single Family Residential District and recommended adoption. Council Member Moore moved to adopt the ordinance. Council Member Glover seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Adopted Ordinance 2007-27 to annex 96.454 acres, property located at 2000 and 2008 Hwy 127. City Manager Lee Gilmour gave the second reading of an ordinance to annex 96.454 acres property located at 2000 and 2008 Hwy 127 as submitted in Petition R-007-009. Property is currently located in Houston County. Council Member Moore moved to adopt the ordinance. Council Member Glover seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Adopted Ordinance 2007-28 to adopt the FY 2008 Operating Budget for the City of Perry. City Manager Lee Gilmour gave the second reading for the FY 2008 Operating Budget. Council Member Glover moved to adopt the ordinance. Council Member Moore seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

7a. Adopted Resolution 2007-31 to establish a Special District for the Langston Road Stormwater Local Design Manual. City Manager Lee Gilmour presented resolution to create Langston Road Special District Stormwater Local Design Manual. Council Member Glover moved to adopt the ordinance. Council Member Moore seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

7b. Appointment of Hearing Officer. City Manager Lee Gilmour recommended the appointment of John Geiger as Hearing Officer per the City's personnel management system. Council Member Moore moved to authorize the appointment. Council Member Glover seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
