

**MINUTES**  
**PRE COUNCIL MEETING**  
**OF THE PERRY CITY COUNCIL**  
**June 15, 2010**  
**5:00 P.M.**

1. Call to Order: Mayor James E. Faircloth Jr., Presiding Officer called to order the pre council meeting on June 15, 2010, at 5:00 p.m.

2. Roll:

3. Items of Review/Discussion: Mayor James E. Faircloth, Jr.

- 3a. Discussion of June 15, 2010 regular meeting agenda. Mayor Faircloth reviewed with Council the regular meeting agenda.

4. Appointment to Boards/Authorities and Commissions. Mayor Faircloth stated he would like to appoint at the next City Council meeting someone to fill the unexpired term of James E. Worrall to the Perry Area Convention and Visitors Bureau. Mayor Faircloth asked Council if they have any nominations for the position to let him know.

7a. Council Consideration of Minutes. Council Member Randall Walker stated on the June 7<sup>th</sup> Special Called meeting it should say “Council Member Randall Walker” instead of Council Member William Jackson relative to the paragraph on the ongoing issue at 701 Evergreen. Mayor Faircloth stated that on the June 1<sup>st</sup> regular meeting minutes item 8a. there was a technical change; instead of passing a resolution it should have been to authorize a change in the fee schedule.

10c. Approval of CM agreement with Parrish Construction Group for provision for water/wastewater operations building. Mayor Faircloth stated that he would recuse himself and turn the meeting over to Mayor Pro-Tempore Willie King because he is employed by Parrish Construction.

4. Other items as needed:

Council Member William Jackson asked if Council binders can be available for use upstairs during the pre council meeting due to any additions and/or changes. City Manager Lee Gilmour stated that the binders will be upstairs for the meetings.

City Manager Lee Gilmour requested an addition to the agenda that would be item 10e. 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of a Beer/Wine Alcohol license for Steamers located at 107 Perimeter Road in the name of Sherry D. Rucker.

Mayor Pro-Tempore Willie King asked Director of Community Development Mike Beecham if there was any response from Kim Mullins concerning issues in Westwood Trailer Park. Mr. Beecham stated he hasn't heard anything from Mr. Mullins.

Director of Parks and Recreation Rick Kilgore requested a waiver for rental fees for Rozar Park for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Kody Lucas blood drive on July 17<sup>th</sup> from 10am. – 3pm. All Council members concurred to add this item to the regular meeting agenda as item 10f.

Director of Public Works Ronnie Jones – following up from questions during City Council work session meeting relative to warranty for the City dump truck. Mr. Jones stated he called and there will be a 2 year unlimited mileage warranty on the engine.

Mayor Faircloth advised that he will be attending the Go Fish Bobberthon Tournament meeting at 2pm at the Go Fish Georgia Center on Friday 18th. Mayor Faircloth passed out information for Council to review. Mayor Faircloth thanked Mayor Pro-Tempore Willie King for conducting the City Council work session meeting on Monday night.

Council Member William Jackson asked about the dress code for the GMA meeting in Savannah. City Manager Lee Gilmour and Council Member Riley Hunt stated that the dress attire is casual.

Mayor Faircloth stated that on Thursday night he will be holding a “Thursday Evening with Jimmy Session” from 5:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. for citizens to come and meet and greet the Mayor and to discuss any issue, concerns and comments. Mayor Faircloth stated he is still trying to schedule an “Exercise Night” with Mayor/Council to walk in various neighborhoods throughout the City.

Council Member Randall Walker asked about the appeal from Peach State Paranormal Investigations. City Manager Lee Gilmour stated that they have asked for an appeal which is scheduled. Council Member Randall Walker suggested Council consider making a policy relative to what is allowed at the City cemeteries. All members agreed. City Manager Lee Gilmour suggested putting together criteria and Council making a decision on a case by case basis i.e. parade permit requests.

5. Adjournment. There being no further business to come before Council, Mayor James E. Faircloth, Jr. adjourned the meeting at 5:33 p.m.
