ARTICLE VI. TRANSIENT MERCHANTS

DIVISION 1. GENERALLY

Sec. 15-131. Restrictions, Permitted Locations, Size of Operation, etc.

No transient merchant having been approved under the terms of this article shall operate such business without strict compliance with the following:

- (a) **Permitted locations.** Transient merchants shall be allowed only in the following described areas:
 - 1) **Sam Nunn Boulevard**, beginning at the junction of Ball Street and Washington Street, extending both sides Sam Nunn Boulevard in a northwest direction to the intersection of Mason Terrace and Sam Nunn Boulevard;
 - 2) **Courtney Hodges Boulevard**, beginning at the junction of Commerce Street and Carroll Street and extending along both sides of Courtney Hodges Boulevard to the intersection of Kellwood Drive and Courtney Hodges Boulevard; and
 - 3) **Macon Road**, beginning at the junction of Commerce Street and Macon Road and extending north along both sides of Macon Road to the intersection of Perimeter Road and Macon Road.
- (b) **Size and Safety of Operation.** No transient merchant shall occupy more than 400 square feet of area on any lot nor erect or set-up any structures or apparatus which in total exceeds 200 square feet.

Any and all structures and apparatus used in conjunction with such a business shall be of substantial construction and material as determined by the building official so as not to constitute a nuisance or hazard to the general public. Such structures and apparatus shall not be vacated nor remain on any property unattended for more than 72 hours and shall be permanently removed upon the expiration date specified in the application.

- (c) Any and all structures, apparatus and signage must be set back ten feet (10') from established rights-of-way.
- (d) Total signage shall not exceed a total of ten square feet per business.
- (e) Applicant must verify to the Zoning Enforcement Officer that adequate parking will be provided without reducing the required parking of any permanent business located on the same lot. Such parking shall be arranged so as not to constitute a traffic hazard.

DIVISION 2. APPLICATION

Sec. 15-132. Occupational Tax Required.

It shall be unlawful for any transient merchant which is a corporation to engage in business in the city without paying the occupational tax required under Article II of this Chapter.

Sec. 15-133. Application.

- (a) Any transient merchant desiring to transact business within the city shall file with the city clerk an application prior to the transaction of any such business. Such application shall include the following information:
- (1) The name and permanent address of the transient merchant;
 - (2) The name and permanent address of the transient merchant's registered agent or office;
 - (3) The type of business to be conducted;
 - (4) The date and state of incorporation, if incorporated;
 - (5) If a foreign corporation, the date the corporation became qualified to transact business in this state;
 - (6) The number of days during which the sale is to be conducted;
 - (7) Evidence of either ownership by the transient merchant or a written lease or written permission from the owner of the property to the transient merchant regarding the property upon which the sale is to be conducted; and
 - (8) The location where the sale is to be conducted.
- (b) No person shall make any false statements in any application to conduct a transient merchant's business.

Sec. 15-134. Regulatory Fee.

- (a) There shall be a regulatory fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) payable in conjunction with the occupational tax upon submittal of an approved application.
- (b) Change in locations or renewals of existing locations will require a new application subject to the established regulatory fee.

Sec. 15-134. Issuance, Term, Etc.

After the applicant has complied with all the provisions of this division, a transient business application shall be approved. Such approval is not transferable, is valid only within the territorial limits of the city, is valid only for the business stated on the application, and shall expire on the last day named therein on which the sale is to be conducted.
