

CITY HIGHLIGHTS

- The City's natural gas line maintenance operations will be managed by ESG Operations, Inc. Over time the change will improve system maintenance and regulatory compliance.
- The Council approved the placement of a bench/statute honoring Mr. Kody Lucas, at the J.E. Worrall Community Center. Mr. Lucas is well known in the Perry area for charity events and his efforts fighting cancer.
- Council approved funding an economic development coordinator position. The person selected will ensure all City funded agencies partner to promote Perry resulting in economic growth and diversity.
- The Council endorsed the Smithsonian's New Harmonies exhibit coming to the Perry Arts Center September 8, - October 20, 2012. The exhibit celebrates American roots music.
- The Council amended its district boundaries to adjust for the 2010 census figures and comply with various State and Federal regulations.
- Council adopted the FY 12 ad valorem millage rate. It increased from 13.81 mills to 14.13 mills due to a decrease in the tax digest value from foreclosures.
