

Invitation to Bid

The City of Perry, GA is soliciting sealed bids for the subsoil waterproofing of its City Hall foundation walls and floor located at 1211 Washington Street per the attached specifications. **Three copies of the Bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the name and bid number clearly marked on the front of the package. Competitive sealed bids will be received at the City of Perry Department of Administration – Purchasing, 1211 Washington Street, P O Box 2030, Perry GA 31069, no later than 2 PM, April 8, 2015.** Bids received after the required time or in any other location other than the Department of Administration will not be accepted.

Bids may be withdrawn by written request only if the request is received prior to the time and date set for the opening of the bids. Negligence on the part of the bidder in preparing his/her bid confers no right of withdrawal or modification of his/her bid after bid has been opened. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty days after the time and date of opening of bids.

The City of Perry reserves the exclusive right to determine which Bidder should be awarded the Contract. The City of Perry also reserves the right to waive any irregularity or informality in a bid, and accepts or rejects any item or combination of items, when to do so would benefit The City of Perry. Also the City of Perry may reject bids that do not contain all elements and information requested. The City of Perry will not be liable for any cost/losses incurred by bidders throughout this process. The City of Perry does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age or disability.

The bidder will indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Perry from and against any and all claims, damages, losses and expenses including, but not limited to, fees and charges of attorneys and court and arbitration costs, arising out of or resulting from the negligent acts, negligent omissions, willful misconduct, or reckless misconduct of the Bidder or anyone whom the Bidder is responsible.

I. Scope of Service

The City of Perry, GA is accepting competitive sealed bids for the subsoil waterproofing of its City Hall foundation walls and floor located at 1211 Washington Street, Perry, GA as shown in the attached diagram.

II. Description of Work to be Performed

- Contractor is responsible for notifying 811 before beginning any excavation to mark all underground utility lines.
- Excavate to the base of foundation walls as shown in diagram in blue.
- Pressure wash all underground portions of walls and repair any openings, bad mortar joints and cracks in the walls.
- Seal the four inch (4") PVC conduit to stop any water infiltration from inside the conduit or around the outside where it penetrates the walls.
- Waterproof the complete underground portion of the foundation walls with a minimum of two trowel coats of elastic hydroxide foundation waterproofing embedded with a Fiberglass mesh.
- Grade the base of the excavated trench towards the South end of the building and install head wall at opening to drain water away from building foundation.
- Place Geotech filtering fabric at the base of excavated trench and up sides of the dirt bank of the excavated trench.
- Install a four inch (4") perforated, filter wrapped, pipe at the base of the trench alongside the foundation footing and gravity drain to South end of the building headwall as shown in diagram indicated in blue.
- Install a minimum of 18 inches of #57 washed stone, encased at the bottom and the complete sides and the top of filtering stone with Geotech fabric to protect from silt entering the filtering stone and four inch (4") perforated drainage pipe.
- Install smooth walled PVC drainage pipes from all the down spouts and away from foundation.
- Backfill and power tamp every 12 inches of soil as it is being backfilled.
- Grade and rake the surface soil to facilitate water runoff away from the building foundation walls.
- Remove shrubs and mature plants along building. Plant bermuda grass seeds in the area where work was completed.
- Coordinate with Building Maintenance Supervisor for the disconnection and reconnection of A/C units as not to disrupt business operations in City Hall. Units should not be disconnected any earlier than 4:00 PM on Friday and reconnected prior to 9:00 AM on Monday.
- Work is to be scheduled for weekend.
- All work must have a minimum 10 year warranty against water seepage.

IV. Contractor Requirements

- Contractor must have current, valid workers compensation insurance coverage.
- Contractor must have current, valid business license from Georgia local government.
- Contractor must have current, valid general liability and vehicle insurance coverage.
- Contractor must be in compliance with current Georgia immigration laws/regulations. The attached contractor's affidavit must be submitted with bid.
- Contractor is responsible for the provision of all supplies, labor, equipment and permits.

V. Bidder Requirements

Any contractor submitting a bid for this project must provide:

- Three (3) commercial or institutional references.
- Copy of current, valid business license.
- Statement of total cost to complete project.
- Estimate time to complete project.

VI. Bid Due Date

All bids must be received in the Department of Administration – Purchasing no later than 2:00 PM April 8, 2015.


VII. Submission of Bid
