GENERAL NATURE OF WORK:

Under direction, responds to fire alarms, emergency medical calls, and other emergency calls to protect life and property; serves as the line officer in responsible command of the activities of an assigned fire company; conducts/participates in fire training, fire prevention, public education, and station and equipment maintenance activities. Receives general supervision from Chief officers. The Fire Captain exercises general and direct supervision over assigned staff.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE GUIDELINES – Any combination of education and experience that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be:

Education/Training: An Associate or Bachelor's Degree in Fire Science, Business Administration, Management, Public Administration or other related course of study applicable to the position is desirable.

Experience: Eight years of full-time fire service experience in a career agency providing a full range of urban fire protection services preferably including two years administrative or supervisory responsibility at the level of Lieutenant.

Licenses and Certificates: Must be able to pass physical examination to meet established health standards. Possession of or the ability to obtain within 12 months a valid State of Georgia Firefighter Certification; valid Georgia or Nationally Registered EMT or Paramedic certification is desirable. Be in possession of or have the ability to obtain an appropriate and valid State of Georgia Driver's License.

Residency Requirement: Must be able to respond from his/her residence to the emergency site within thirty (30) minutes. Based on these criteria employee must reside within a 27.50 mile radius of his/her emergency response site.

This position is open to both internal and external candidates. Preference will be given to qualified current City employees.

*All Fire Safety Personnel hired from after January 1, 2013, shall be required to remain a nonsmoker and refrain from the use of any tobacco product throughout their employment as a member of the Perry GA Fire and Emergency Services Department.

Individual filling this position is subject to pre-employment, post-accident and random drug testing.
