GENERAL NATURE OF WORK: The purpose of this position is to assist in the fire suppression and emergency management activities as well as to provide front-line supervision at emergency scenes as well as fire station facilities.

Minimum Qualifications:

- NPQ Firefighter II (External candidates only) or Sergeant pay grade (internal candidates only).
- EMT Intermediate or higher certification.
- NPQ Fire Instructor I.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Knowledge and level of competency commonly associated with the completion of specialized training in the field of work.
- Sufficient experience to thoroughly understand the scope of work of subordinate positions in order to possess the ability to answer questions and resolve problems at the company officer level.
- Successful completion of the Georgia Fire Academy and Georgia Public Safety Training Center courses of:
 - Incident Command System/NIMS/ICS (NIMS 100, 200, 700, 800 are required).
 - Should the candidate not have the recommended classes completed as outlined in the departmental matrix, they shall have one calendar year from the date of hire/promotion to have successfully completed any delinquencies.
- Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's license issued by the State of Georgia for the type of vehicle or equipment to be operated.
- Ability to meet current requirements set forth by the National Fire Protection Association and the Georgia Firefighter Standards and Training Council.
- Two years of time in grade as a Sergeant according to the Career Tracking Matrix is preferable for internal candidates. External candidates shall submit any course certificates applicable to the company officer/leadership skillset. These will be used in conjunction with the listed work history in the application to determine a point value for experience.

Residency Requirement: Applications are accepted from nonresidents of the City of Perry. Any applicant selected for a position in the Fire & Emergency Services Department shall move within a 27.50 mile radius of Fire Headquarters within one year of the individual's employment.

This position is open to both internal and external candidates. Preference will be given to qualified current City employees.

HOW TO APPLY:

Internal Candidates: Submit cover letter and resume to Personnel Office no later than the ending date of this posting.

External Candidates: Complete City of Perry Application for Employment package along with a cover letter and resume no later than the ending date of this posting.

*All Fire Safety Personnel hired from after January 1, 2013, shall be required to remain a nonsmoker and refrain from the use of any tobacco product throughout their employment as a member of the Perry GA Fire and Emergency Services Department.

Individual filling this position is subject to pre-employment, post-accident and random drug testing.
