GENERAL NATURE OF WORK:

Perform the duties of a Firefighter. Controls and extinguishes fire, protects life and property, maintains equipment. Performs assigned duties in maintaining apparatus, quarters, buildings, equipment, grounds and hydrants.

REQUIREMENTS:

Must have current/valid Georgia driver's license. Must successfully complete pre-employment testing to include Physical Agility Test and Entrance Assessment, polygraph examination, physical exam and pre-employment drug screen. Firefighters work 24/48-hour shift assignments.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (Firefighter Recruit):

High school diploma or GED equivalency. Must be at least 18 years of age or older and capable of obtaining a class B driver's license. Must live or be able to relocate to within 27.5 miles of city limits. No Previous Experience or State Firefighter Certification required. The first 14 weeks of Recruit Training and successful completion is required to continue your 12 month probationary period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (Firefighter I or Firefighter II):

Must meet minimum qualifications for Firefighter Recruit plus be a State Certified Firefighter I or II with full or part-time experience with career or combination department.

(Out of State Firefighter Certification transition to Georgia Firefighter Certification requires Firefighter I written test and competency practical assessment which are conducted interdepartmentally by our training staff. Successful completion is required within 3 months to continue your 12 month probationary period.)

*All Fire Safety Personnel hired from City of Perry eligibility lists after January 1, 2013, shall be required to remain a nonsmoker and refrain from the use of any tobacco product throughout their employment as a member of the Perry GA Fire and Emergency Services Department.
