GENERAL NATURE OF WORK:

Part-time Firefighters are used to supplement the backfilling of career positions vacant due to personal leave, and provide staffing for special events and public education details.

REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY TO APPLY:

- Certification as a firefighter by the State of Georgia.
- Current full time employment as a certified firefighter with another agency.
- Possession of a valid State of Georgia driver's license with favorable MVR.
- Completion of standard high school course of instruction or its equivalent.
- Favorable background investigation as determined by a review of Federal, State and Local reporting agencies.

HOW TO APPLY:

To be accepted your completed application package must contain the following documents when submitted:

- Complete a City of Perry Employment Application & Criminal History Consent Form.
- Copy of your State of GA Firefighter Certification, and if an EMT or Paramedic, copies of those certification(s) also.
- A letter from your department's training officer verifying that your training for the last 12 months is up to date with State of Georgia 24 hours annually.
- Provide documentation that you have successfully passed in the last 12 months a medical physical confirming fitness for duty as a firefighter.
- Must provide a copy of a valid GA driver's license.

These positions require pre-employment, post-accident and random drug testing.

Candidates will be notified of selection status. Qualified applicants not selected will remain on an active list and may be selected as future positions become available.

All Fire Safety Personnel hired from City of Perry eligibility lists after January 1, 2013, shall be required to remain a nonsmoker and refrain from the use of any tobacco product throughout their employment as a member of the Perry Ga Fire and Emergency Services Department.
