GENERAL NATURE OF WORK:

Part-time Firefighters are used to supplement the backfilling of career positions vacant due to personal leave, and provide staffing for special events and public education details.

REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY TO APPLY:

So as to ensure seamless integration of individuals without compromising the operational functionality of our department all individuals interested;

- Must currently be employed as a Full-time Career Fire Officer or Firefighter with:
 - The City of Warner Robins Fire Department,
 - The Peach County Fire Department, or
 - Have been a career Fire Officer, Driver Operator or Firefighter who left in good standing from the Perry Fire and Emergency Services Department.
- Consideration will be given to Career Fire Officer or Firefighter from any other department following review and approval by the Command Staff of Perry GA Fire & Emergency Services Department.

WHAT YOU MUST DO TO BE CONSIDERED FOR SELECTION:

- Complete a City of Perry Employment Application & Criminal Back Check Authorization Form.
- Supply a copy of their State of GA Firefighter Certification, and if an EMT or Paramedic copies of those certification(s) also.
- A letter from their department's training officer verifying their rank within the department, and that their training for the last 12 months is up to date with State of Georgia 24 hours annually.
- Provide documentation that they have successfully passed in the last 12 months a medical physical confirming they are fit for duty as a firefighter.
- Must possess and provide a copy of a valid GA driver's license.

If selected to serve in one of these positions applicants will have to successfully pass a pre-employment drug test and criminal background check.

All Fire Safety Personnel hired from City of Perry eligibility lists after January 1, 2013, shall be required to remain a nonsmoker and refrain from the use of any tobacco product throughout their employment as a member of the Perry Ga Fire and Emergency Services Department.
