3a. Award of Bid(s):

1. Bid No. 2014-17 Ford Interceptor Utility Vehicle or Comparable for K-9

Awarded Bid No. 2014-17 Ford Interceptor Utility Vehicle or Comparable for K-9 to low bidder Brannen Motor Company. Mayor Pro Tempore Walker presented for Council's consideration bids for a Ford Interceptor Utility Vehicle or Comparable for K-9. Staff recommendation to Council to award the bid to low bidder Brannen Motor Company in the amount of \$30,406.81.
