Sealed Proposals for the Ag Village Water Main Extension for the City of Perry will be received until 2:00 PM local time, Tuesday, August 18, 2016 in the Department of Administration - Purchasing, 1211 Washington Street, Perry, Georgia 31069, Attn: Brenda King, Director of Administration, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) calendar days.

E-Verify Requirement: All bidders shall provide their signed E-Verify affidavit with their bid. Bids will not be considered without the Contractor affidavit. The successful bidder is responsible for obtaining a signed E-verify affidavit from their Subcontractors and Sub- subcontractors.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor necessary to install a water main under US Highway 41 South by means of jack and boring. The work shall be installed as detailed on the construction drawings and specified herein and all incidental work required for a complete and functional installation. Contractors are responsible for traffic control and erosion control. All construction shall comply with the Georgia Department of Transportation Specifications, 2013 Edition and City of Perry Standard Specifications.

Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents. Complete bid documents may be obtained from Ocmulgee, Inc., 906 Ball Street, Perry, Georgia 31069, 478-224-7070, upon deposit of \$50.00 per set, NON-REFUNDABLE.

Bonds: All bid bonds must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount. The successful bidder, if awarded the Contract, will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount and a Payment Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount.

License: The Bidder shall hold a current Contractor's License issued by the Georgia State Construction Industry Licensing Board.

Owner's Right: The City of Perry reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any technicalities and informalities and re-advertise. The City of Perry further reserves the right to award this contract in whole or in part.
