The City of Perry is soliciting sealed bids for the repair of the Perry – Chapel RD/Ford Creek Landfill located at 261 Toomer Road final cover, Perry, GA. **Three copies of the Bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the name and bid number clearly marked on the front of the package. Competitive sealed bids will be received at the City of Perry Department of Administration – Purchasing, 1211 Washington Street, P O Box 2030, Perry GA 31069, no later than 2 PM, September 29, 2015.** Bids received after the required time or in any other location other than the Department of Administration will not be accepted.

Bids may be withdrawn by written request only if the request is received prior to the time and date set for the opening of the bids. Negligence on the part of the bidder in preparing his/her bid confers no right of withdrawal or modification of his/her bid after bid has been opened. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty days after the time and date of opening of bids.

The City of Perry reserves the exclusive right to determine which Bidder should be awarded the Contract. The City of Perry also reserves the right to waive any irregularity or informality in a bid, and accepts or rejects any item or combination of items, when to do so would benefit The City of Perry. Also the City of Perry may reject bids that do not contain all elements and information requested. The City of Perry will not be liable for any cost/losses incurred by bidders throughout this process. I. Scope of Service

The City of Perry is soliciting sealed bids for the repair of the Perry – Chapel RD/Ford Creek Landfill final cover.

II. Description of Work to be Performed

Furnish all necessary labor, materials and equipment required to accomplish the following:

- Grading and repairing areas of the landfill that have been damaged due to erosion, settling and subsidence. The damaged areas are to be covered with clean, compacted earth and the final grades are to be adequately sloped to allow storm water runoff. (e.g. no depressions with ponded water or wetland vegetation on the disposal area).
- Silt fencing is to be installed prior to work being performed to limit/control erosion.
- Storm water run-on is to be diverted around all areas used for solid waste disposal to limit erosion of the cover soils and infiltration.
- Apply fertilizer, temporary (rye grass - minimum 40 pounds per acre) and permanent (unhulled bermuda - minimum 6 pounds per acre) grassing to the repaired areas.
- The vegetative layer should perform the following functions: stabilize the soil against erosion by water and wind; minimize percolation down to the waste; maximize evapotranspiration of moisture from the soil material cover and enhance the natural beauty (aesthetics) of the site.
- The required repairs are to be completed in accordance with the Georgia Rules for Solid Waste Management as amended.

IV. Contractor Requirements

- Contractor must have current, valid workers compensation insurance coverage.
- Contractor must have current, valid business license from Georgia local government.
- Contractor must have current, valid general liability and vehicle insurance coverage.
- Contractor must be in compliance with current Georgia immigration laws/regulations. The attached contractor's affidavit must be submitted with bid.
- Contractor is responsible for the provision of all supplies, labor, equipment and permits.

V. Bidder Requirements

Any contractor submitting a bid for this project must provide:

- Three (3) commercial or institutional references.
- Copy of current, valid business license.
- Statement of total cost to complete project.
- Estimate time to complete project.

The City of Perry Solid Waste Division will be available to visit the site with any, and all, bidders upon request. To schedule a visit please contact Todd Ennis, Solid Waste Supervisor, at (478) 338-0238 or Decius T. Aaron, Director of Public Works, at (478) 951-4928. Bidders are not permitted to access the landfill area unless accompanied by the Solid Waste Supervisor or the Director of Public Works. All bidders are encouraged to make a personal inspection of the entire site and thoroughly familiarize themselves with the site to verify dimensions and conditions prior to the submission of their bid. Failure to inspect the site will not serve as just cause for changes due to unknown conditions.

VI. Bid Due Date

All bids must be received in the Department of Administration – Purchasing no later than 2:00 PM September 29, 2015.

VII. Submission of Bid

Bid documents must be clearly marked on outside “City Hall Waterproofing Bid #2016-10. No fax transmissions or emails will be accepted. Bids received after the required time or in any other location other than the Department of Administration will not be accepted. Bid are to be submitted to:


