Highlights

- Council rescinded the moratorium on historical structures being demolished or moved. The revised certificate of appropriateness process addresses Council's concerns.
- Council heard a presentation from a Georgia Power representative concerning the closing of the Perry office.
- Council approved proceeding with the installation of the City's new branding logo on its five (5) water tanks.
- Council adopted a special events application process.
- Council approved using the Perry Public Facilities Authority to fund the improvements for certain City parks.
- Council approved modifying its aeration basin improvements to address phosphorus removal.
- Council authorized an audit of the hotel/motel tax providers.
