Highlights - Revised

- Council established a policy for minimum qualifications for drivers of City vehicles.
- Council appointed members of the Perry Public Facilities Authority.
- Council awarded bids for:
 - Main Street Water Main upgrade \$441,172
 - Airport Road Extension culvert upgrade \$240,576
 - South Perry Parkway striping \$ 79,681
- Council approved a consent agreement with the Georgia Public Service Commission as the final step in resolving a natural gas system leak policy.
- Council concurred with the donation of a shelter at the dog park.
- Council examined options for the provision of public transportation to its residents and visitors.
- Council agreed to examine options to address the issues of lighting and solid waste disposal in the downtown district.
- Council approved having the Department of Community Development be responsible for all certificates of appropriateness applications.
- Council affirmed its policy not to annex property outside of its designated service area.
- Perry Police Department within four (4) days of report that Mr. Sam Poss was missing, resolved the case and arrested his two murderers.
