Job Summary:

Part time role that is responsible for general maintenance and operations and performance of duties at the Creekwood Park Splash Pad for the duration of the operating season, which generally runs from late May to early September, weather dependent.

Essential Tasks. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- Open and close the splash pad as scheduled.
- Greet, interact, and communicate with the diverse population in a fair, consistent, and professional manner.
- Maintain a positive, polite, considerate, and cooperative attitude.
- Opens and closes the splash pad as scheduled.
- Assists customers, program participants, and volunteers during program activities, ensuring proper conduct and appropriate use of the facilities and grounds.
- Maintains Leisure Services facilities in accordance with department standards; monitors and cleans restrooms and grounds as needed.
- Assists with maintaining logs of chemical testing at aquatic facility.

Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities Required:

- Ability to work effectively with minimal supervision alone and in group environments.
- Basic knowledge of aquatic and/or recreation programs.
- Ability to meet, advise, assist, and if needed, coordinate with various groups or department activities.
- Inspect areas to be used for safety.

Reports to:

Director of Leisure Services.

Physical Demands:

Work requires moderate physical effort, typically involving some combination of stooping, kneeling, crouching, and crawling, and which may involve some lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling of objects and materials of moderate weight. Some tasks require the ability to communicate orally.

Work Environment:

Work is generally performed outdoors in all weather conditions. The incumbent will be assigned to a Monday through Sunday, **Flexible days, and hours** between 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. shift.
