



**SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND/OR EXERCISED:**

- Position reports to the Director of Public Works and/or Solid Waste Manager.
- Position is responsible for training and supervision of assigned staff, though evaluation of staff members will be conducted by Director of Public Works or Solid Waste Manager. Incumbent will occasionally direct task groups as assigned.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

- Class A criteria job demand

**WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

- Work is performed outdoors under dirty, uncomfortable, noisy, and hazardous conditions and in all types of weather conditions.
- Duties requires good eye-hand coordination to operate robotic controls and the ability and stamina to perform heavy manual physical labor, move items weighing in excess of 50 lbs. on a repetitive basis, as well as the ability to crawl, climb, bend, twist, stoop, kneel and to maintain such activities throughout a work shift.
- Work also involves equipment operation in residential areas as well as in heavy traffic.
- Weekend, holiday and after-hours work are sometimes required, as well as after-hours response and emergencies.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High school diploma or GED required.
- Five years increasingly responsible experience in solid waste operations, including three years of supervisory experience required; or any equivalent combination of education, training and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities to perform this job.
- Possession of a Carl Vinson Institute of Government Succeeding as a Supervisor certificate or equivalent.
- Must possess and maintain a valid Georgia Commercial Driver's License (CDL) throughout employment.
- Must maintain an acceptable Motor Vehicle Record throughout employment.

This position requires pre-employment, post accident, and random drug screening.
