**REFERENCE:** Carroll Street Improvements

Based on comments presented to you, the Administration recommends Council authorize proceeding with designing the below improvements in the 800 and 900 blocks of Carroll Street.

- Remove plant beds and replace with brick.
- Include up-lighting under trees and sidewalk connecting Commerce Street parking lot with Carroll Street.
- Replace current street lights with downtown standard lights..
- Install power outlets by trees.
- Place party lights in trees.

The purpose of these improvements would be to provide more lighting, reduce maintenance costs, provide more space for events, reduce liability, create a festive environment, and provide adequate power for events.

This will be discussed at your January 3, 2016 pre-council meeting.
