GENERAL NATURE OF WORK:

The purpose of this position is to supervise the daily operations of a company of fire suppression personnel assigned to a fire station or apparatus, with full responsibility for all company personnel during normal activities, fire suppression and emergency management operations.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Two (2) years as a Sergeant with the Perry Fire Department for internal candidates. External candidates must have six (6) years full time experience with a similar fire department, with a minimum of two (2) years at the rank of Sergeant or equivalent.

- EMT Intermediate or higher certification.
- NIMS 100, 700, 200, 800, 300
- Incident Safety Officer
- Rescue Systems

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

- An Associate or Bachelor's Degree in Fire Science, Business Administration, Management, Public Administration or other related course of study applicable to the position.
- The following certifications: Fire Instructor 1, Fire Inspector 1, Fire & Life Safety Educator, HazMat Technician.
- The following courses: Interior Search & Rescue, Structural Fire Control, Crash Victim Extrication, Practical Fireground Hydraulics, Pump Service Testing, Acting Officer in Charge, NFPA Fire Apparatus Operator – Pumper, Leadership for Fire and EMS 1-3.
